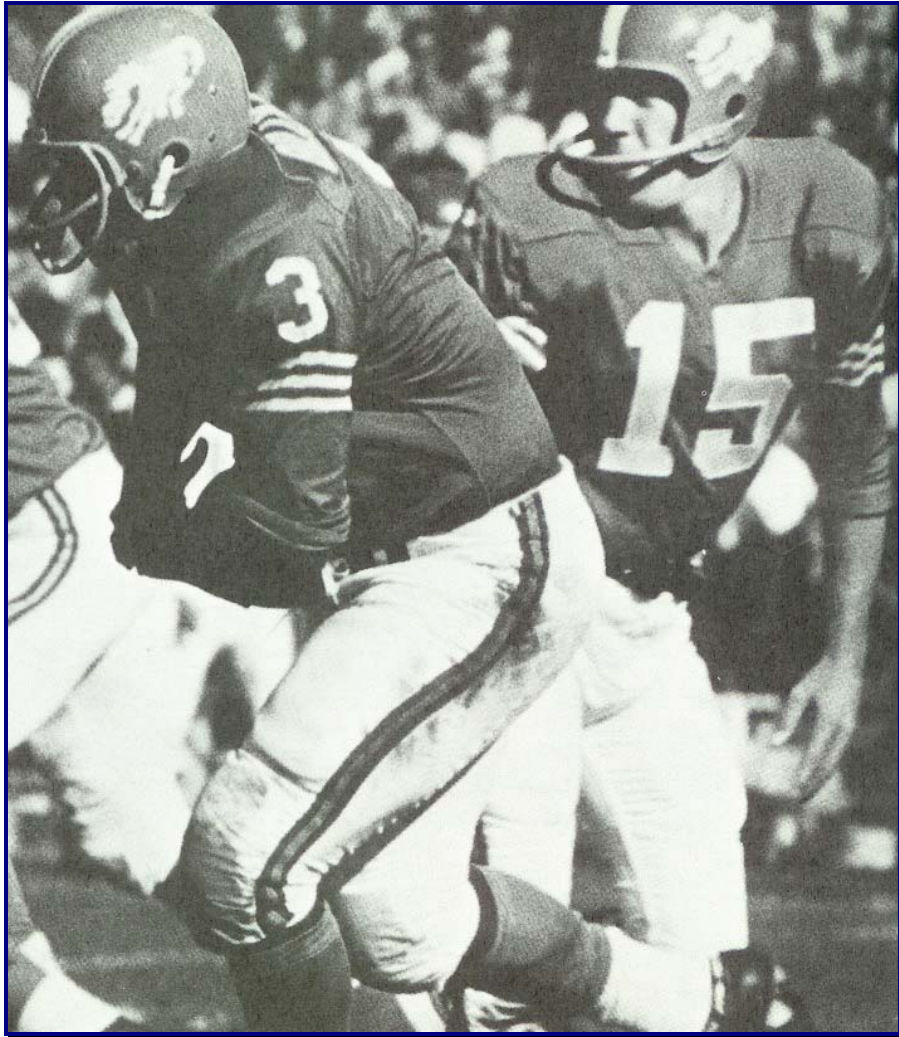


Fig. 64-1. 1964 home uniform (C. Gilchrist, Oct 11)
