Manufacturer: Nike (by Ripon Athletic?)¹
Unique Features: Year of issued incorporated into manufacture's collar label
Design/Style Notes: Elite 51 style - Hydrophobic 4-way stretch material with zoned mesh ventilation areas; partial contrasting-color flywire collar tapers to a point where the shoulder/sleeve meets the body; Hydrophobic 4-way stretch side panel inserts in contrasting color arch up and to a point forming a stripe along each side of the jersey; ¼-length sleeves; three distinct cuts available: LINE, Q-BK, SKILL.

- Manufacturer's: "No-tag" neck label affixed to rear of collar (See: Figs. 12-8 & 12-11)
 - Year: Black "flag" tag sewn adjacent to manufacturer's label in collar
 - Size: Incorporated into "Manufacturer's" label; added/subtracted length, when applicable, noted on "flag" tag sewn adjacent to manufacturer's label, opposite of year tag.
 - Other:
 1. Navy blue Nike logo patch on sleeves below numbers
 2. Rubberized NFL shield patch affixed onto the center of the collar
 3. "BRONCOS" embroidered stitch below apex of collar (white on home jersey; blue on road)

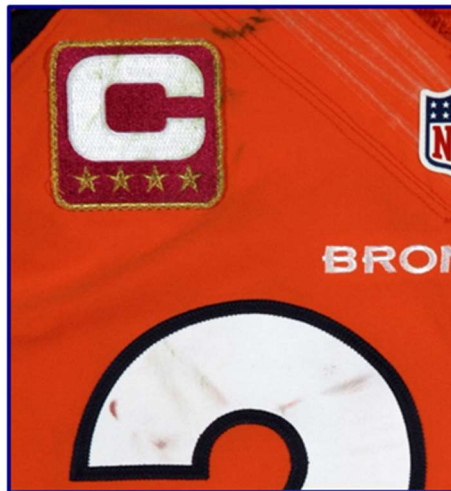


Fig. 12-7. Captain's patch with pink background, worn during the month of October, commemorating Breast Cancer Awareness

 4. "C" patch (white or gold "C" on orange/blue field with gold border) designating team's captains affixed to right chest of jersey (see Fig. 12-7); worn by CB Champ Bailey (5), DE Elvis Dumervil, G Chris Kuper* (3), QB Peyton Manning, RB Willis McGahee** (2) and LB Wesley Woodyard (4) (See: Fig. 12-5). Patches with white or gold "C" on pink field with white border worn during October in observance of breast cancer awareness month (See: Fig. 12-7). Patches with white or orange "C" on camouflage field with gold border worn Nov 11th and Nov 18th in observance of "Salute to Service" (military appreciation).
 5. Hall of Fame "50 Years" commemorative patch to upper left breast of jersey Dec 6th at Oakland and 16th at Baltimore (See Fig 12-6)

 - ** Through Chris Kuper's return

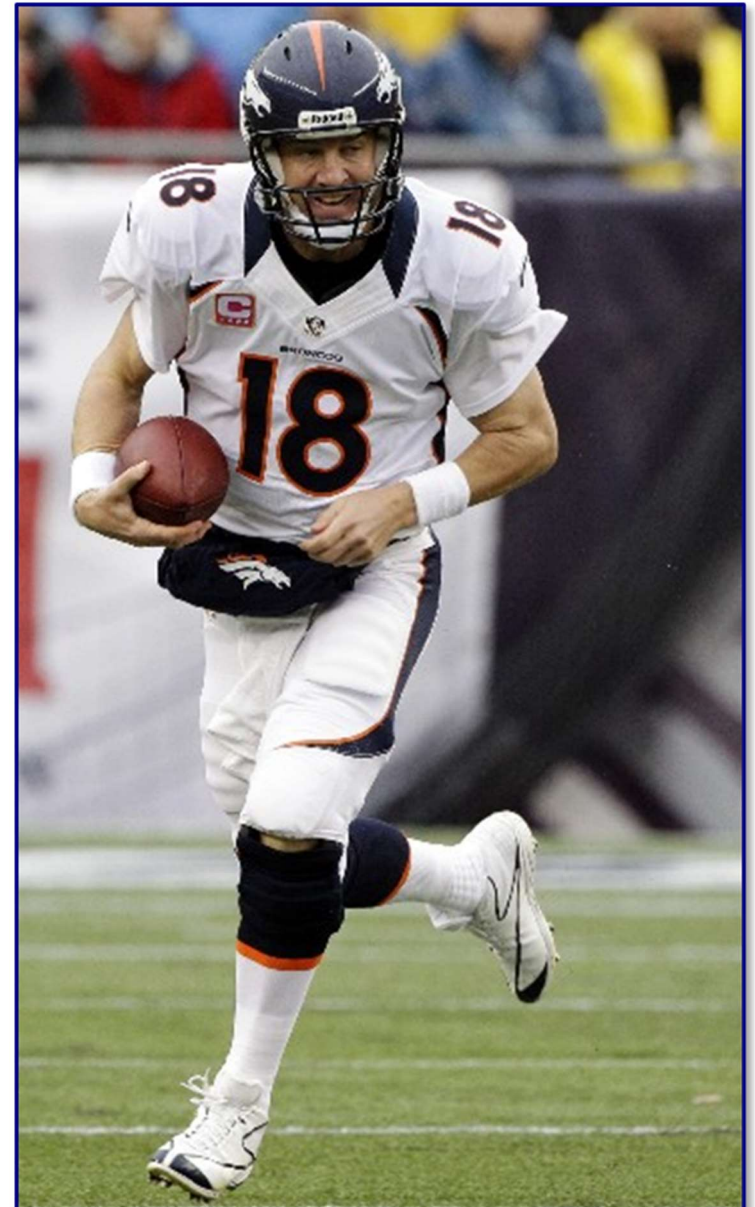
¹ Following an eleven-year run by Reebok, Nike signed a multi-year contract with the NFL to become the league's official supplier of on-field uniforms for all thirty-two teams. It had been reported that due to Nike's capacity limitations, up to 25 of the 32 teams' jerseys continued to be manufactured by Ripon Athletics who'd previously manufactured NFL game jerseys for Reebok. It is unknown whether or not the Broncos jerseys/uniforms for 2012 and beyond were produced by Nike or by Reebok, under Nike's license.

² Coinciding with the change of manufacturers, the Broncos formally changed their "home" uniform's jersey color from navy blue to orange (which had been used occasionally as a alternate home jersey since 2004). From 2012 and beyond, navy blue jerseys became the alternate home jersey's color

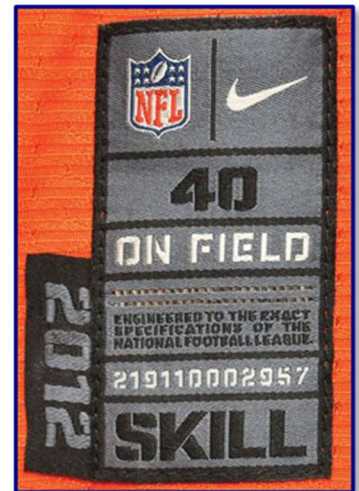


Fig. 12-8. 2012 Nike manufacturer's tagging detail
